DESCRIPTION

A trowel grade mastic made with asphalt, water and reinforcing fillers and fibers. It has a smooth paste like consistency that spreads easily and provides an even, quick drying film. SPECIFICATIONS: ASTM D1227, TYPE II, CLASS 1 AND D 1187, TYPE 1

USES

This material is most often used as a dampproofing compound on the exterior of masonry walls above and below grade. It cannot be used when subject to freezing temperatures or rainfall before it thoroughly dries. Used in dampproofing applications to masonry surfaces where a heavy coat is desired. This material may be applied to a new, or "green", damp surface. It requires no heating or thinning prior to application. This product may be used as a base and surface compound in which a reinforcing membrane is embedded.

METHODS AND RATE OF APPLICATION

Apply to a damp surface which is free from grease, dirt and oil. Apply with a trowel or with special mastic spray equipment to thickness of about 1/8 inch at rate of one gallon (3.78 liters) per 13 square feet ($1.2M^2$.) Apply at 50° F and rising. Wait 48 hours before backfilling when applied below grade.
